Staying at home if you're sick is the best thing you can do to stop the spread of COVID-19. School policy is that parents should take the temperature of their child prior to leaving for school. The child should remain at home if they record a temperature of 37.5 °C or higher.

If the student shows the following symptoms they should stay home,

Symptoms include:

- fever with or without rashes
- shortness of breath

(Shortness of breath is a sign of possible pneumonia and requires immediate medical attention.)

- sneezing and runny nose
- Eye infections-(Itchy,watery,red or swollen eyes)
- Diarrhea
- nausea and vomiting

If the child has any of these symptoms, "Stay at Home"
